





The Conway Public Library sent 6 teams this year to compete in the Odyssey Nor'Easter on April 5th at Edward Little High School in Auburn, ME. This regional competition included 99 teams from Maine, New Hampshire, and Massachusetts. Our teams began meeting in September to prepare solutions to their chosen Long-Term Problem. Four of our teams won 1st place for New Hampshire in their problem/division! A huge thank you to our volunteer coaches - Amy DuFault, Kate Lamneck, Jennifer McCracken, and Kristin Groves - for making it possible to host so many Odyssey teams this season!

Tessa applied for and was accepted to attend the NELLS (New England Library Leadership Symposium) Tier 2 Mid-Career Librarianship program. This four-day intensive training program focuses on the application of leadership theory to real-world library issues and is designed to develop skills necessary in a senior leadership role, such as creating an equitable workplace/public space, leading through change, self-care, mentoring talent, developing a strong vision, building strong communities, and resilience.

NNHLC is celebrating National Library Week by offering library tours at a different co-op library each day of the week. Visitors can collect special bookmarks and stickers at each library. Bob will be providing hourly tours of the historic elements in our building this Friday.
