
July 2025 - Library Visits

Another successful Mission to Mars was completed by 15 local students in the Ham Community Room this summer. Based on the Perseverance Rover, campers had to successfully retrieve their own Martian samples and return them safely to Earth. Their simulated mission required they learn about and utilize a programmable robotic arm, VEX IQ robotics kits, 3D printers, drones, model rockets, VR, coding, and Minecraft. This is the 5th year this camp has been hosted at the Conway Public Library in collaboration with Project Succeed and the MWV School to Career Partnership camps.



Bob presented his newest hands-on outreach program about simple machines to over 200 individuals as part of the relocation of the Jackson Historical Society museum building. Kids and adults alike were able to experience historical uses of simple machines, such as rolling a barrel up an inclined plane, to help



explain and interpret the mechanisms of the moving operation and to compare tools and techniques of the past and the present.
