

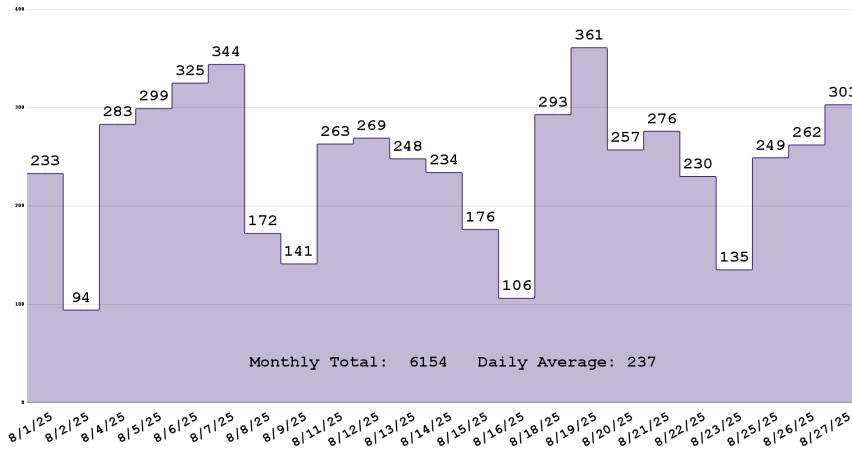

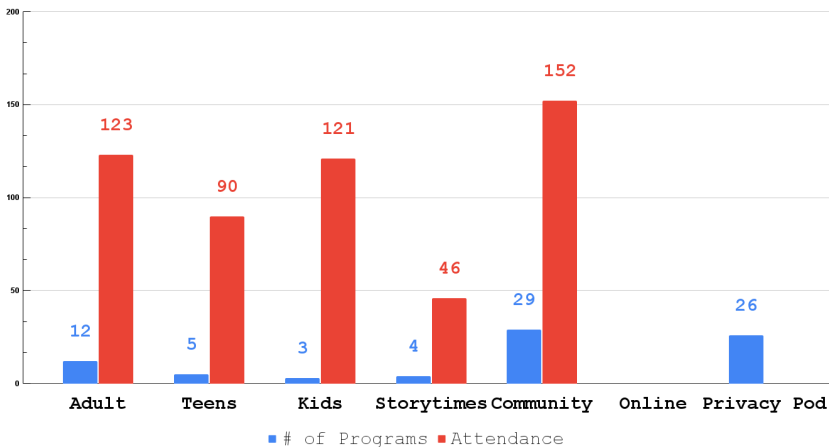

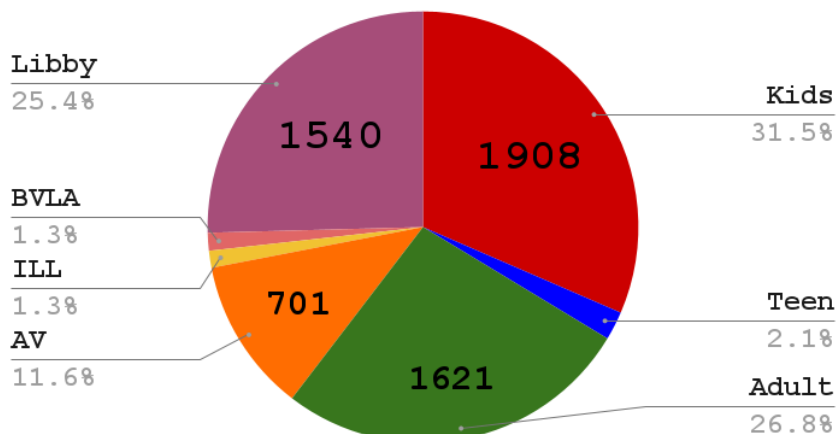


August 2025 Programs

53 Programs with 532 attendees

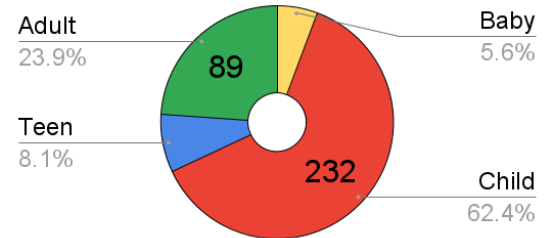


August 2025 - Circulation: 6058 items

Our new Movin' and Groovin' at the Library program kicked off on Friday mornings for children ages 2-5. Tessa designed this program to combine the early literacy elements of Story Time with creative movement to encourage the development of gross motor skills, spacial and body awareness, social interaction, emotional expression, imagination, and self-esteem.

BJ Parker, General Assistance Officer for the Town of Conway, attended our August staff meeting to discuss homelessness in our community and impacts seen at the Library.

The clock tower is fully functioning again, following a service call from D'Avanza Clock Repair. We received improvement recommendations to prevent the counter weight pulley issue in the future, and the clock hands were synced so that all three faces match.

Three paintings by Ernie Brown of covered bridges in the Conway Village area have been generously loaned to the Library by Sut Marshall for display in the Great Hall. Bob is currently working with Kennett High School to borrow the fourth covered bridge painting to display the set together again for the first time in decades.

Jeff attended a two-day course on CISM Application with Children at DHHS. In November, he will complete basic training to join New Hampshire's Disaster Behavioral Health Response Team with the goal of centering the library as a space for community information, resources, and healing during future natural disasters and times of crisis.
